offering a comprehensive overview of military conflict over several centuries this book consists of fascinating thematic chapters covering air and sea warfare combat experience technology and even opposition to war

this book explores the issue of civilian devastation in modern warfare focusing on the complex processes that effectively establish civilians identity in times of war underpinning the physicality of war s tumult are structural forces that create landscapes of civilian vulnerability such forces operate in four sectors of modern warfare nationalistic ideology state sponsored militaries global media and international institutions each sector promotes its own constructions of civilian identity in relation to militant combatants constructions that prove lethal to the civilian noncombatant who lacks political power and decision making capacity with regards to their own survival civilians and modern war provides a critical overview of the plight of civilians in war examining the political and normative underpinnings of the decisions actions policies and practices of major sectors of war the contributors seek to undermine the tunnelling effect of the militaristic framework regarding the experiences of noncombatants this book will be of much interest to students of war and conflict studies ethics conflict resolution and ir security studies

woodworth shows how the lack of a unified purpose and strategy in the east sealed the confederacy s fate

this book investigates the use and utility of military force in modern war after the cold war western armed forces have increasingly been called upon to intervene in internal conflicts in the former third world these forces have been called upon to carry out missions that they traditionally have not been trained and equipped for in environments that they often have not been prepared for a number of these new types of operations in allegedly new wars stand out such as peace enforcement state building counter insurgency humanitarian aid and not the least counter terrorism the success rate of these missions has however been mixed providing fuel for an increasingly loud debate on the utility of force in modern war this edited volume poses as its central question what is in fact the utility of force is force useful for anything other than a complete conventional defeat of a regular opponent who is confronted in the open field this book will be of much interest to students of strategic studies war and conflict studies counter insurgency security studies and ir isabelle duyvesteyn is an associate professor at the department of

how do armies fight and what makes them victorious on the modern battlefield in divided armies jason lyall challenges long standing answers to this classic question by linking the fate of armies to their levels of inequality introducing the concept of military inequality lyall demonstrates how a state s prewar choices about the citizenship status of ethnic groups within its population determine subsequent battlefield performance treating certain ethnic groups as second class citizens either by subjecting them to state sanctioned discrimination or worse violence undermines interethnic trust fuels grievances and leads victimized soldiers to subvert military authorities once war begins the higher an army s inequality lyall finds the greater its rates of desertion side switching casualties and use of coercion to force soldiers to fight in a sweeping historical investigation lyall draws on project mars a new dataset of 250 conventional wars fought since 1800 to test this argument project mars breaks with prior efforts by including overlooked non western wars while cataloguing new patterns of inequality and wartime conduct across hundreds of belligerents combining historical comparisons and statistical analysis lyall also marshals evidence from nine wars ranging from the eastern fronts of world wars i and ii to less familiar wars in africa and central asia to illustrate inequality s effects sounding the alarm on the dangers of inequality for battlefield performance divided armies offers important lessons about warfare over the past two centuries and for wars still to come

many anthropological accounts of warfare in indigenous societies have described the taking of heads or other body parts as trophies but almost nothing is known of the prevalence of trophy taking of this sort in the armed forces of contemporary nation states this book is a history of this type of misconduct among military personnel over the past two centuries exploring its close connections with colonialism scientific collecting and concepts of race and how it is a model for violent power relationships between groups

remarkably not a single american was killed in combat

this is the first book to apply the clausewitzian trinity of passion chance and reason to the experience of real war it explores the depth and validity of the concept against the conflicts of former yugoslavia wars thought to epitomise a post clausewitzian age in doing so it demonstrates the timeless message of the trinity but also ties the trinitarian idea back into clausewitz s political argument intended to build on the existing corpus of scholarship this book differs from the existing literature in two ways by applying the trinity to the wars of former yugoslavia 1991 1995 it explores war at its micro foundations assessing the complex cause and effect nexus of reciprocity produced by actions between belligerents embroiled in dynamic competition perpetuated by their own interaction providing valuable insights into the complexities of real war fuelled by passion undermined by chance and shaped by reason it is the first study to bridge the clausewitzian world of theory with real experience examining each part of the triad separately the book explores the multiple manifestations of hostility and chance before then assessing the influence of these elements on the policies of the belligerents as the war evolved

2023 gold medal in biography memoir from the military writers society of america john spencer was a new second lieutenant in 2003 when he parachuted into iraq leading a platoon of infantry soldiers into battle during that combat tour he learned how important unit cohesion was to surviving a war both physically and mentally he observed that this cohesion developed as the soldiers experienced the horrors of combat as a group spending their downtime together and processing their shared experiences when spencer returned to iraq five years later to take command of a troubled company he found that his lessons on how to build unit cohesion were no longer as applicable rather than bonding and processing trauma as a group soldiers now spent their downtime separately on computers communicating with family back home spencer came to see the internet as a threat to unit cohesion but when he returned home and his wife was deployed the internet connected him and his children to his wife on a daily basis in connected soldiers spencer delivers lessons learned about effective methods for building teams in a way that overcomes the distractions of home and the outside world without reducing the benefits gained from connections to family

arab and israeli sources and reveals that if truth is the first casualty of war then history is the first casualty of peace

from one of the most important army officers of his generation a memoir of the revolution in warfare he helped lead in combat and in washington when john nagl was an army tank commander in the first gulf war of 1991 fresh out of west point and oxford he could already see that america s military superiority meant that the age of conventional combat was nearing an end nagl was an early convert to the view that america s greatest future threats would come from asymmetric warfare guerrillas terrorists and insurgents but that made him an outsider within the army and as if to double down on his dissidence he scorned the conventional path to a general s stars and got the military to send him back to oxford to study the history of counterinsurgency in earnest searching for guideposts for america the result would become the bible of the counterinsurgency movement a book called learning to eat soup with a knife but it would take the events of 9 11 and the botched aftermath of the iraq invasion to give counterinsurgency urgent contemporary relevance john nagl s ideas finally met their war but even as his book began ricocheting around the pentagon nagl now operations officer of a tank battalion of the 1st infantry division deployed to a particularly unsettled quadrant of iraq here theory met practice violently no one knew how messy even the most successful counterinsurgency campaign is better than nagl and his experience in anbar province cemented his view after a year s hard fighting nagl was sent to the pentagon to work for deputy secretary of defense paul wolfowitz where he was tapped by general david petraeus to coauthor the new army and marine counterinsurgency field manual rewriting core army doctrine in the middle of two bloody land wars and helping the new ideas win acceptance in one of the planet s most conservative bureaucracies that doctrine changed the course of two wars and the thinking of an army nagl is not blind to the costs or consequences of

counterinsurgency a policy he compared to eating soup with a knife the men who died under his command in iraq will haunt him to his grave when it comes to war there are only bad choices the question is only which ones are better and which worse nagl's memoir is a profound education in modern war in theory in practice and in the often tortured relationship between the two it is essential reading for anyone who cares about the fate of america's soldiers and the purposes for which their lives are put at risk

this excellent biography of one of the us army's unsung heroes provides a much needed re examination of the early post vietnam army bowling green daily news by the 1970s the united states army was demoralized by the outcome of the vietnam war and shifting attitudes at home the institution as a whole needed to be reorganized and reinvigorated and general william e depuy was the man for the job in 1973 depuy was appointed commander of the newly established training and doctrine command tradoc by integrating training doctrine combat developments and management in the us army he cultivated a military force prepared to fight and win in modern war general william e depuy is the first full length biography of this key figure in american military history with extensive interviews with those who knew depuy as well as access to his personal papers henry g gole chronicles and analyzes his unique contributions to the army and nation gole guides the reader from depuy's boyhood and college days in south dakota through the major events and achievements of his life during world war ii depuy served in the 357th infantry regiment in europe from the normandy invasion until 1945 when he was stationed in czechoslovakia depuy was asked by george patton to serve as his aide he supervised clandestine operations in china he was instrumental in establishing special forces in vietnam and he briefed president lyndon b johnson in the white house but his finest contribution was fixing a broken army

by the end of the sixteenth century stories about the revolt in the low countries c 1567 1648 had begun to spread throughout europe these stories had very different authors with very different intentions over time the plethora of sources and interpretations faded away leaving us with opposing canonical narratives the dutch and spanish national myths were forged on the basis of two visions of the conflict as a liberation war against cruel spanish oppressors and as a glorious episode in the history of the spanish empire this volume delves into the early seemingly anecdotal stories of the war to map the great variety and interconnection of the narratives it asks such questions as how did the jesuits write about the revolt what can we find in italian chronicles and how did the war look from the perspective of a local nobleman or a spanish commander

most students of history assume that the age of the warlord popes ended with the renaissance but long after the victory of catholic powers at the battle of lepanto in 1571 the papacy continued to entangle itself in martial affairs the vatican participated in six major military campaigns between 1796 and 1870 flew the papal flag over a warship as late as 1878 and during the second world war mobilized more than 2 000 of its own troops to defend the pope david alvarez now opens up this little known aspect of the papacy in the first general history of the papal armed forces his is the first book in english to provide a comprehensive chronicle of the modern vatican's military and security forces from 1796 when the armies of revolutionary france invaded the papal states through the wars for unification to the present day deployment of modern weapons technology and skills to protect

the holy father and the vatican from terrorists and assassins most papal histories make little reference to military affairs while the few that address them do so only in passing or focus narrowly on particular units or campaigns alvarez s history expands our understanding of the papacy s military through the exceptional research he has done as the first american scholar to gain access to the archive of the pontifical swiss guard and the modern military records in the vatican secret archive he is also the first historian of any nationality to use the records of the vatican gendarmeria alvarez chronicles the exploits of the vatican s military leaders and soldiers in their campaigns and battles focusing on how those units under the pope s authority including the vatican navy engaged in actual military operations he also deals extensively with the vatican gendarmeria as well as the pope s noble guards palatine guards and swiss guards describing their distinctive responsibilities and revealing the competition and internal tensions that sometimes undermined the morale preparedness and cohesion of the pope s guards filled with information that will surprise scholars of the papacy and military historians alike alvarez s highly original work illuminates a shadowy corner of vatican history and will fascinate all readers interested in the role of the church in the broader world
